



LogiTemp is an advanced electronic controller system that enhances food safety while minimizing energy and installation expenses. It is standard on Split-Pak freezer refrigeration systems 6 H.P. and above and optional on other systems.

LogiTemp Plus with Reverse Cycle Defrost

LogiTemp Plus with Reverse Cycle Defrost is an optional feature for Split-Pak systems 6 H.P. and above. It offers significant additional advantages, including:

- Rapid and complete removal of ice build-up in evaporator coils to prevent food spoilage.
- Reduced defrost energy usage by up to 80% compared to electric heaters, with defrost times as short as 3-5 minutes for freezers and 1-1/2 to 2 minutes for coolers
- Saves refrigerant through reduced charge requirements
